

# SAFETEA-LU Checklist Summary

Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) is the federal legislation that outlines the requirements for the transportation planning process including the development of the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). SAFETEA-LU requires that the LRTP have at least a twenty-year horizon and address 8 planning factors. To make sure that Genesee County is addressing all 8 planning factors a checklist was created. The Genesee County 2035 LRTP addresses all 8 planning factors as outlined in the chart below. The report also includes a staff review of corrective actions and recommendations from the 2006 certification review of the transportation Planning Process in Genesee County

## SAFETEA-LU Planning Factors

1. Support the economic vitality of the United States, the States, non-metropolitan areas, and metropolitan areas, especially by enabling global competitiveness, productivity, and efficiency
2. Increase the safety of the transportation system for motorized and non-motorized users
3. Increase the security of the transportation system for motorized and non-motorized users
4. Increase the accessibility and mobility of people and for freight
5. Protect and enhance the environment, promote energy conservation, improve the quality of life, and promote consistency between transportation improvements and State and local planned growth and economic development patterns
6. Enhance the integration and connectivity of the transportation system, across and between modes throughout the State, for people and freight
7. Promote efficient system management and operation
8. Emphasize the preservation of the existing transportation system
