Argentine Township—Removal of Architectural Barriers—\$57,650

Argentine Township has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$228,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The removal of architectural barriers to the Township Fire Hall, completed in 2014, made accessibility improvements for voters, meeting attendees, and those conducting regular business. Since 2001, Argentine Township has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Facility—\$135,276 Infrastructure—\$92,996

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—3 houses—\$59,487 invested
