City of Burton has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$5.5 Million in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The above infrastructure improvements project, completed in 2013, included ditching, repaving, and upgraded the sewer system on Decamp Road. Since 2001, the City of Burton has invested funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$342,850

Public Facility—\$853,791

Infrastructure—\$1,309,166

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—113 houses—\$1,914,831
