City of Davison—Housing Rehabilitation—\$624,400

City of Davison has benefited from the HOME Investment Partnerships program by receiving more than \$660,000 in funding that has been invested in community development. Since 2001, the City of Davison has invested Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding in the following categories:

Infrastructure—\$133,354

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—4 houses—\$53,529
