City of Flushing - Demolition - \$30,970

City of Flushing has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$140,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The demolition of an old gas station on Main St., completed in 2002, and made it possible to erect this village square. Since 2001, the City of Flushing has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$16,766

Infrastructure—\$17,903

Demolition—\$30,970

Public Facility—\$7,768

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—4 houses—\$77,811
