City of Linden has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$420,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The above improvements project at Loose Senior Center, completed in 2014, included replacement of the roof, windows, siding, and shingles, painting of the brick, and A.D.A. improvements to the porch. Since 2001, the City of Linden has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$69,335 Public Facility—\$180,885 Infrastructure—\$140,348

Home Improvement Project (HIP)—2 houses—\$32,375
