City of Montrose has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$200,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The above park improvements in Blueberry Park provided fencing improvements including, new top rails, posts and vinyl coated chain link material, and was completed in 2012. Since 2001, the City of Montrose has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$565

Public Facility—\$38,920

Infrastructure—\$39,610

Home Improvement Program (HIP) - 6 houses—\$125,057
