City of Mt. Morris has benefited from the HOME Investment Partnerships program by receiving more than \$910,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The above new construction project of Rosewood Apartments, completed in 2001, has provided housing for low-and moderate-income residents. Since 2001, the City of Mt. Morris has invested Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding in the following categories:

Public Service - \$65,873 Public Facility - \$10,000 Infrastructure - \$68,274

Home Improvement Program (HIP) - 10 houses—\$189,725
