Fenton Charter Township has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$485,000 in funding, that has been invested in various community development projects. One example, is the above ditching project, which included Jennings, Odell, and Thompson Roads, and was completed in 2013. Since 2001 Fenton Charter Township has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Facility—\$85,590

Demolition—\$29,988

Public Service—\$91,593

Infrastructure—\$114,745

Home Improvement Program (HIP) - 8 houses—\$135,502
