Flushing Charter Township—Removal of Architectural Barriers—\$30,570

Flushing Charter Township has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$435,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The removal of architectural barriers project, completed in 2011, added automatic doors to the Township Hall and the Police Department. In addition, these locations, as well as the Nature Park, added handicap parking, curb-cuts, and sidewalks for wheelchair accessibility. Since 2001, Flushing Charter Township has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$224,467

Public Facility—\$21,440

Infrastructure—\$30,570

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—13 houses—\$164,629
