Montrose Charter Township has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$595,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The above sidewalk improvements project, completed in 2015, improved safety and aesthetic for Montrose commuters and low-and moderate-income residents. Since 2001, Montrose Charter Township has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$19,233 Public Facility—\$216,079 Infrastructure—\$94,141

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—17 houses—\$265,801
