**Richfield Township** has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$394,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The above street improvements project on Potter Road, completed in 2012, has benefited low-and moderate-income residents. Since 2001, Richfield Township has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

**Public Service—\$2,756**

**Public Facility—\$75,589**

**Infrastructure—\$128,863**

**Demolition—\$51,000**

**Home Improvement Program (HIP)—8 houses—\$136,752**
