Vienna Charter Township has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$1 Million in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The above senior center facility improvements project, completed in 2012, provided funding for the purchase of an emergency generator and protective cover. Since 2001, Vienna Charter Township has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$53,049 Public Facility—\$290,522 Infrastructure—\$309,815

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—27 houses—\$381,075
