Over \$51,000 Invested in Community Development



Village of Otter Lake—Removal of Architectural Barriers—\$4,511

Village of Otter Lake has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$51,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. The above removal of architectural barriers project, completed in 2012, replaced the existing doors with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) approved automatic doors. Since 2001, Village of Otter Lake has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Facility—\$9,917

Infrastructure—\$4,476

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—2 houses—\$37,040
