

# Emterra Curbside Recycling

## COLLECTION INFORMATION

**TRASH AND RECYCLE PICKUP** → If a holiday falls on or before Wednesday, pickup will be one (1) day later than normal. **If a holiday falls on a weekend, Sat. or Sun. your scheduled pickup day will not change.** **OBSERVED HOLIDAYS ARE:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

**All materials should be set at the curb by 7:00 a.m.** on the scheduled day of pickup. Containers should not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds each. For those with special pickup needs contact your Township Office.

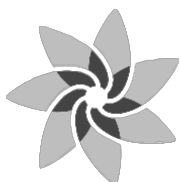
**UNACCEPTABLE MATERIAL:** Tires, concrete, fencing, and contractor generated materials; free liquids (paints, pesticides), car parts, and appliances containing Freon; fluorescent bulbs (in excess of seven per household), car batteries.



## RECYCLING

Recycling bins are available by calling your Township Hall  
**For a replacement bin you must bring your damaged bin back to the Township.**  
**YOU DO NOT NEED TO SORT RECYCLABLE ITEMS!**

Newspaper	Place newspapers, phone books, magazines & glossy newspaper inserts in brown paper bags or bundle and tie with string
Cardboard	Clean corrugated cardboard must be bundled and tied in two (2) foot squares, not exceeding a thickness of one (1) foot.
Plastic (#1 – 7)	Plastics should be rinsed clean with the cap removed. No motor oil, anti-freeze, or cooking oil containers please.
Cans	Clean tin and aluminum cans. These items may be flattened to conserve space in your container.
Glass	Only <b>clear</b> empty glass. The glass must be rinsed out.
