Subject: Genesee County 2045 Long Range Plan (LRTP) Call for Transportation Capacity Related Projects

Dear Applicant:

The Genesee County Metropolitan Alliance, with staff assistance from the Genesee County Metropolitan Planning Commission (GCMPC), is developing the *Genesee: Our County, Our Future* planning document that encompasses both the community development and transportation long range planning documents. For the Transportation division this represents the Genesee County 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). GCMPC is now accepting transportation capacity related project applications for the 2045 LRTP. All Act 51 agencies are eligible to submit an application for capacity-related improvements to federal-aid eligible roads in their jurisdiction. Townships should contact the Genesee County Road Commission to discuss potential projects to submit for this call.

Capacity projects submitted must address deficiencies as identified by the 2014 and 2045 maps of CMP deficiencies provided on the website identified at the end of this notice. The application includes a Congestion Management Process (CMP) Checklist and a Project Application. The checklist and application must be filled out and submitted together.

The CMP Checklist is a self-assessment of the current condition of the proposed corridor as it relates to congestion management and should be completed prior to filling out the project application. The checklist walks the applicant through the CMP toolbox to help determine the best option for improving the operation of the corridor.

The Project Application requests information on improvements proposed for the project corridor. A portion of the application is scored to help prioritize the submitted projects

Information for road corridors that have been identified as a deficiency has been included on the website with the intent to help applicant agencies fill out the checklist and application without the assistance of an engineering

consultant. The project costs provided should be estimates based on average project costs.

All project applications must be received by GCMPC by **Wednesday, July 31, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.** Applications will then be evaluated, scored, and endorsed by the appropriate committees. The application packet is available on our website by going to www.gcmnpc.org.
