City of Clio has benefited from the HOME Investment Partnerships program by receiving more than \$960,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. Since 2001, the City of Clio has invested Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding in the following category:

Infrastructure—\$104,897

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—3 houses—\$51,297
