

CHECK YOUR TIRE PRESSURE



Properly inflated tires can keep you safe, save you money, and improve air quality.



Tires can lose up to **2** PSI of pressure every month. **Check tire pressure monthly.**

Tires that are under inflated by 6 PSI can decrease fuel economy by **3%**



Properly inflated tires reduce traffic congestion due to flats caused by uneven tread wear.

Find the recommended tire pressure for your vehicle.

Look for the tire placard on the inside of your car door, or consult your owner's manual. Most vehicles have a recommended tire pressure between 30 and 35 PSI

Checking tire pressure? Check your tires too.

If you see **bubbles, chips, cuts, cracks, or bulges**, have the tire inspected by a professional.
