

10 Carpool Tips for a Successful Commute

- Set specific pick up and drop off times.
- Determine a designated route and stick to that route.
- Decide how long the group will wait for latecomers.
- Make sure all drivers have insurance.
- Decide if food, drink, and smoking will be allowed in the vehicle.
- Decide whether the radio will be on or off. Choose a station beforehand.
- Exchange phone numbers. Contact the group if an emergency arises.
- Notify the group when a member has a scheduled vacation or shift change.
- Each member should have a backup plan in case an unforeseen change occurs.
- Decide on driver reimbursement if driving is not being shared equally.
