MINUTES

The Genesee County Technical Advisory Committee met at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 1, 2025, in the Harris Auditorium of the Genesee County Administration Building, 1101 Beach Street, Flint, Michigan, 48502.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Patsy called the meeting to order at approximately 1:32 p.m.

II. ROLL CALL

III. MINUTES

***** A. Minutes of the April 3, 2025 Regular Meeting**

Motion: Action: Approve, **Moved by** Ellen Glass, **Supported by** Robert Cole, to approve the minutes of the April 3, 2025 regular meeting as presented. **Motion carried unanimously.**

IV. OLD BUSINESS

A. Genesee County Master Plan Update

Mr. Cody Roblyer provided an update on the Master Plan Update by showing the Master Plan website at www.ourfuturegenesee.org. On the website, the plan and individual reports can be viewed, and comments can be made. Staff had public sessions at three local colleges, Mott Community College, University of Michigan-Flint, and Kettering University with a survey specific to college students. Emails will also be sent to college

students with the survey. During “take your child to work” day at Genesee County, one of the activities done by staff was a survey specific to kids.

V. NEW BUSINESS

A. FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Technical Correction

Mr. Kris Garris stated that a technical correction has been made for the 2025 Local Livability and Sustainability GPA in the FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This GPA contains one 2025 Safe Routes to School project from the City of Linden. This project has been in progress for a few years with improvements such as 5 foot sidewalks on both sides of Hyatt Lane and a 10 foot concrete pathway on the north side of Stan Eaton Drive.

*****B. FY 2027 Safety Call for Projects List**

Mr. Cody Robyler stated in February, MDOT held a call for FY 2027 Safety Call for Projects which were due to MDOT on May 1, 2025. Staff received six local safety program applications which were reviewed according to MDOT Time-of-Return Analysis.

Mr. Alex Patsy stated that the City of Burton came to him wanting to put in an application.

Mr. Abdul Khandker stated the City of Flint has submitted three projects to MDOT.

Mr. Jacob Maurer stated that staff has found out it is no longer a requirement by MDOT to have an endorsement, however this would be an additional check from the MPO.

Discussion ensued.

Motion: Action: Approve, **Moved by** Ellen Glass, **Supported by** Michael Pifer, to approve the FY 2027 Safety Call for Projects List. **Motion carried unanimously.**

*****C. FY 2026 Unified Work Program**

Mr. Jacob Maurer stated that staff has made progress on the Unified Work Program. The 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan is anticipated to be completed in mid-winter, a new Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) cycle will begin October 1st, 2025, staff will be completing work with consultant, AECOM, who has been working on the Transportation Safety Action Plan, along with regular work items. Staff is also looking at a potential partnership with Flint Township for a planning study along Bristol Road for pedestrian safety and accessibility.

Staff were looking at updating the Transportation Travel Demand model, however this will now be completed in the next fiscal year. This correction will be made before going to the Metropolitan Alliance for approval.

Motion: Action: Approve, **Moved by** Robert Cole, **Supported by** Michael Pifer, to approve the FY 2026 Unified Work Program. **Motion carried unanimously.**

D. Traffic County Survey Requests

Mr. Kris Garris stated that Genesee County Metropolitan Planning Commission (GCMPC) requests annually for local units of government to update traffic count information on roads under their jurisdiction. GCMPC has traffic counters and accessory equipment available for rental by local jurisdictions. The counters collect vehicle counts as well as vehicle classification and speed. Staff is available to assist with set-up and training. Optimal times for taking traffic counts are in the spring before schools are out for the summer and in the autumn after the Labor Day holiday. Tuesday through Thursday generally provides the best average weekday count.

Discussion ensued.

E. Genesee County 2050 LRTP Capacity Deficiencies

Mr. Kris Garris stated last month staff brought the capacity deficiencies list for the 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan to the committee and requested feedback from local units and also met with road agencies. Staff have reviewed feedback, and changes were made to the map. These changes have been approved by the Master Plan Steering Committee on April 22nd, 2025.

Mr. Jacob Maurer states that level service F disappears from the 2050 map due to upcoming projects. Additionally, the population employment projection changes.

Discussion ensued.

F. LRTP 2050 Capacity Call for Projects

Mr. Kris Garris stated the Genesee County Metropolitan Planning Commission (GCMPC) is now accepting transportation capacity-related project applications for the 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). All Act 51 agencies are eligible to submit an application for capacity-related improvements to federal-aid eligible roads in their jurisdiction. Project applications must be received by GCMPC by May 16, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. Applications will then be evaluated, scored, and endorsed by the Genesee County Master Plan Steering Committee.

VI. OTHER BUSINESS

A. Election of Officers

Mr. Jacob Maurer stated this committee has an annual rotation for elections where seats are held by Large Cities, Small Cities/Villages, the MTA, and the Road Commission. The Road Commission will be on the bye for the 2025-2026 rotation. Up for nomination for the 2025-2026 (a continuation of the current rotation) would be: Abdul Khandker, Large Cities as Chairperson, Melinda Johnson, MTA as Vice-Chairperson, and Adam Zettel, Small Cities/Villages as Secretary.

VII. ANNOUNCEMENTS

A. NFC Revisions

Mr. Jacob Maurer stated every ten years, because of the census, staff will go over the adjusted census bureau boundaries. The next step is to certify the National Function Class (NFC). The county will be putting together a county-wide workshop for road agencies to attend to see if any of their roads within the MPO boundary, in the urban boundary need to be re-classified. If a municipality is proposing a change in functional classification, it must be justified and must be a federal aid road. Discussion ensued.

Mr. Maurer announced "save the date" information will be sent out for the June 5th Economic Seminar.

Mr. Alex Pasty announced the Road Commission will be starting paving projects in May.

Mr. Maurer announced that a "save the date" for a Trail Symposium on June 11th, 2025, will be sent out. Genesee County, along with the support of the Mott Foundation, are putting on this Trail Symposium.

SUBJECT: FY 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Approval

At the April meeting of the Technical Advisory Committee, staff presented a draft version of the FY 2026-2029 TIP document. The required 30-day public comment period began on Sunday, April 20th, 2025, and ended Tuesday, May 20th, 2025. A public hearing was held on May 21st, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. in Room G51 on the ground floor of the Genesee County Administration Building. Attached is a copy of the main FY 2026-2029 TIP document. SUBJECT: **Approval of the Air Quality Conformity Analysis for the Flint MI Conformity Area (Genesee and Lapeer Counties)**

At the April meeting of the Technical Advisory Committee, staff presented a draft version of the Air Quality Conformity Analysis for the Flint MI Conformity Area, as part of the FY 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) document. The draft Air Quality Conformity Analysis makes the determination that our FY 2026-2029 TIP and its projects satisfy all requirements in the Air Quality Conformity regulations. The FY 2026-2029 TIP conforms to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for the 1997 ozone standard based on the results of the conformity analysis. The attached resolution makes a formal conformity determination after the Genesee County Metropolitan Alliance approves and signs it.

The required 30-day public comment period began on Sunday, April 27th, 2025, and ended Tuesday, May 27th, 2025. A public hearing was held on May 21st, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. in Room G51 on the ground floor of the Genesee County Administration Building.

The Air Quality Conformity Analysis document is attached for review. Staff have received zero public comments on the proposed Air Quality Conformity Analysis document, which has been incorporated into the document and can be found at the following link:
