V. NEW BUSINESS

*****A. FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #24**

Ms. McKenna Dutkiewicz stated this amendment abandons one project and changes one GPA in the FY 2023-2026 TIP. The project being abandoned is the City of Burton Bristol and Belsay Roads roundabout. This project was taken to their City council in July and voted to be abandoned. The project included carbon reduction and CMAQ funds which need to be used this year. With limited projects the funding could be moved to, staff is recommending that the funding be moved to the Flint Mass Transportation Authority (MTA) which has two projects in 2026 which can be moved to 2025.

Ms. Amber Abbey from the City of Burton stated that this project was abandoned due to over 100 people attending the public hearing meeting demanding the roundabout does not happen. The decision to abandon the project was due to public outcry and the City of Burton apologizes as they were not expecting this to happen. Discussion ensued.
