III. MINUTES

*****A. Minutes of the November 6, 2025 Regular Meeting**

Motion: Action: Approve, **Moved by** Robert Cole, **Supported by** Corey Jarbeau, to approve the minutes of the November 6, 2025 Regular Meeting as presented. **Motion carried unanimously.**

IV. OLD BUSINESS

*****A. 2026 Safety Performance Measure Targets**

Mr. Kris Garris stated on October 14th, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) provided Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPOs) with statewide safety targets for the calendar year 2026. In 2025, the Metropolitan Alliance adopted the 2025 Statewide Safety Targets. Crash trends locally in Genesee County are very similar to statewide trends. The deviations found are not enough to warrant adopting local targets rather

than the statewide targets. Staff is recommending TAC provide a recommendation of approval to the Genesee County Metropolitan Alliance to adopt the statewide safety targets for 2026.

Motion: Action: Approve, **Moved by** Andrea Schroeder **Supported by** Ellen Glass to approve the recommendation of approval to the Genesee County Metropolitan Alliance to adopt the 2026 Safety Performance Measure Targets. **Motion carried unanimously.**

*****B. Genesee County Master Plan**

Mr. Cody Roblyer stated staff has prepared the draft version of the County-wide Master Plan document. The plan is now ready to go out for public comment. This plan serves as the county's long-range plan as well as the master plan. Five key themes from the plan and the public engagement were presented.

Mr. Dan Moulton presented the technical reports which were created to help create the plan. These technical reports will be available on-line for communities to use. Fiscal restraints, county priorities and visions were discussed. Next the public comment period from December 22, 2025 to February 23, 2026 will take place. Following the public comment period, a public hearing will take place on February 25, 2026.

Motion: Action: Approve, **Moved by** Robert Cole, **Supported by** Andrea Schroeder to approve the Draft of 2025 Genesee County Master Plan for Public Comment. **Motion carried unanimously.**

C. Strategic Trails Plan Update

Mr. Kris Garris stated the Strategic Trails Plan draft may be ready in early 2026. Meetings with township officials have been taking place to discuss local non-motorized priorities. Meetings with Michigan State University and C.S. Mott Department of Public Health Team have also taken place to discuss opportunities to collaborate. Meetings with MDOT and the DNR will take place soon.

D. 2025 PASER Data Collection Update

Mr. Kris Garris stated staff have finished collecting the PASER road rating data on the local non-federal aid roads in the county. Staff is in the process of completing the full PASER report. The local roads rated as good were 6%, fair 16% and poor 78%. Discussion ensued.

V. NEW BUSINESS

*****A. FY 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #3**

Ms. McKenna Dutkiewicz stated this Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) changes one GPA, and adds three GPAs to the FY 2026-2029 TIP. The one GPA which is changing is the Transit GPA. The three new GPA's are: 2026 Trunkline Livability and Sustainability GPA, 2027 Trunkline Road GPA, and the 2029 Trunkline Road GPA.

Motion: Action: Approve, **Moved by** Robert Cole, **Supported by** Corey Jarbeau to approve the FY 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #3. **Motion carried unanimously.**

SUBJECT: 2026 Michigan Transportation Asset Management Council PASER Training Dates

The Michigan Transportation Asset Management Council (TAMC) has announced their annual PASER Program training dates and times. Through this program, the pavement condition of all federal aid roads in the State of Michigan are surveyed using the PASER Road Rating System. The program consists of 2 classes: PASER 1 and PASER 2. Both classes must be completed in order to rate roads. The road rating certification is valid for 3 years. Training dates for 2026 are as follows:
