Since 2001, the City of Fenton has invested Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$82,986

Infrastructure—\$50,337

Public Facility—\$138,233

Blight Removal—\$63,768

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—11 houses—\$214,154
