Thefford Township has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program by receiving more than \$665,000 in funding that has been invested in various community development projects. Funding for the above street improvement project allowed for the milling and repaving of Lyle Meadow Lane, Woodbridge Drive, and Millwright Circle. Since 2001, Thefford Township has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$26,757 Public Facility—\$150,477 Infrastructure—\$267,970

Home Improvement Program—15 houses—\$224,884
