Community Development Program



Over \$48 Million Invested in Genesee County

Approximately \$35 Million in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funding

Approximately \$13 Million in HOME Investment Partnerships Funding



Public Service

Allocation—\$1,935,259

Public Service projects help serve over 14,000 seniors annually.



Public Facilities and Improvements

Allocation—\$5,776,708

Funding also helps with blight removal and demolition of hazardous structures like the Ramada Inn (above).



Home Improvement Program (HIP)

Allocation—\$9,838,719

The HIP program has funded improvements for 590 homes.



Housing

Allocation—\$10,579,073

Housing assistance for our most vulnerable populations is possible because of this funding, like Lockwood of Burton (above).
