District 5 includes the following communities: Atlas Township, Village of Goodrich, City of Grand Blanc, and Grand Blanc Charter Township. Since 2001, Genesee County’s 5th District has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$312,155

Infrastructure—\$515,241

Public Facility—\$902,481

Demolition—\$302,912

Home Improvement Program (HIP)— 45 houses—\$733,420
