District 6 has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME programs by receiving more than \$4.5 Million in funding that has been invested in various community development projects throughout the district. District 6 includes the following communities: Argentine Township, Mundy Charter Township, Grand Blanc Charter Township, Fenton Charter Township, City of Fenton, and the City of Linden. Since 2001, Genesee County’s 6th District has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$344,802

Infrastructure—\$953,921

Public Facility—\$875,778

Demolition—\$183,668

Home Improvement Program (HIP)— 30 houses—\$550,116
