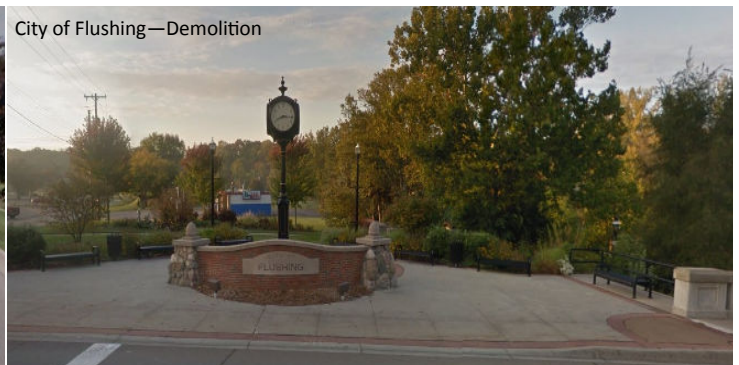
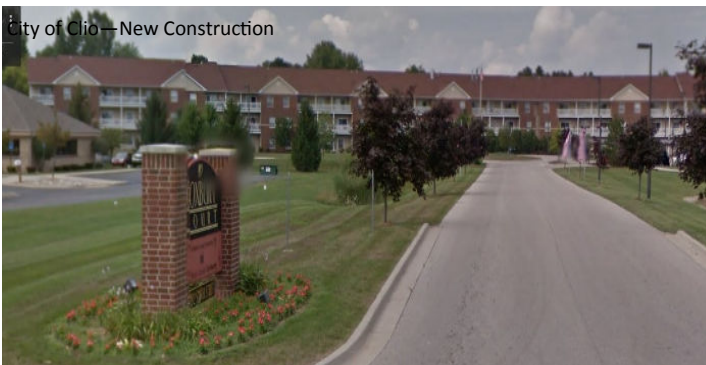
District 7

Over \$4.1 Million Invested in Community Development

District 7 has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME programs by receiving more than \$4.1 Million in funding that has been invested in various community development projects throughout the district. District 7 includes the following communities: Montrose Charter Township, City of Montrose, Vienna Charter Township, City of Clio, Thetford Township, Flushing Charter Township, and the City of Flushing. Since 2001, Genesee County’s 7th District has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$340,837

Public Facility—\$725,206

Infrastructure—\$864,906

Home Improvement Program (HIP)— 80 houses—\$1,213,726
