District 8 has benefited from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME programs by receiving more than \$7.6 Million in funding that has been invested in various community development projects throughout the district. District 8 includes the following communities: Clayton Charter Township, City of Swartz Creek, Gaines Township, Village of Gaines, Mundy Charter Township, Flint Charter Township, and Mt. Morris Charter Township. Since 2001, Genesee County’s 8th District has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$1,350,345

Infrastructure—\$2,338,797

Public Facility—\$238,799

Demolition—\$846,924

Home Improvement Program (HIP)— 55 houses—\$957,839
