Since 2001, Genesee County’s 9th District has invested CDBG funding in the following categories:

Public Service—\$352,069

Infrastructure—\$1,628,426

Public Facility—\$372,235

Demolition—\$532,810

Home Improvement Program (HIP)—45 houses—\$741,233
